Loyal supporters and first-timers united to make last summer's gathering a true celebration of the importance of our vibrant farming community, recognizing their hard work and commitment to bringing fresh, healthful food to tables across the Piedmont and beyond.

It's hard to put into words how grateful we are for the ever increasing support of this festival, which began as a one-off party to recognize Carlo Petrini and the [Slow Food Movement](#) and became one of the most anticipated culinary weekends in our region. It not only brings well-deserved attention to farmers and chefs who appreciate the bounty of our land, but also directs proceeds to benefit the [Center for Environmental Farming Systems](#) (CEFS) and the [Breeze Farm Enterprise Incubator](#), providing hands-on training and mentorship to young and second-career farmers committed to ensuring that communities continue to have access to locally-grown food.

This year some major changes are afoot: Instead of scheduling three major culinary events on consecutive days, the 2018 Farm to Fork will separate its happenings to take greater advantage of our evolving growing season. The **Farm to Fork Picnic**, historically our final feast, will now launch the series on **Sunday, June 3**. We'll return to the beautiful grounds of [Farrington Village](#), where dozens of our area's best chefs and artisan producers will partner with farmers who use sustainable practices to produce a vast array of fruit, vegetables, meats and dairy products.

We'll reconvene on **September 16** with a pop-up dinner featuring **Jacob Boehm** of [Snap Pea Underground & Catering](#). Boehm's monthly dinner events are the stuff of [legend](#) across the Triangle. The self-taught chef dazzles guests with a multi-course, hyper-local meal designed around a compelling theme, gathering diners in bucolic outdoor settings or dramatic indoor spaces not typically associated with fine dining. While specific details will not be announced until days before the event, we guarantee that Boehm will be cooking with seasonal ingredients at their peak, provided by some of our best known farm partners.

On **December 6**, we'll present our final event of the series amid the fragrant setting of [Lavender Oaks Farm](#) in Chapel Hill with guest speaker **John T. Edge**, author of critically acclaimed [The Potlikker Papers: A Food History of the Modern South](#). A prolific writer and insightful social commentator, Edge is director of the influential Southern Foodways Alliance. This celebration of Southern food will be a sort of moveable feast, with dishes prepared by six prominent chefs at different stations. Beverages from local craft makers will be featured, along with live music and merriment.

This year, we hope to support twice as many farmer apprentices and interns kicking off their careers in sustainable agriculture!
