In years past, we have asked the chefs to donate their supplies, ingredients, time and effort. **This year, we are requesting you, the farmer, donate ingredients/product to the dish, as a contribution to the cause or offer 50% off of the wholesale price for produce of 25% off the wholesale price for all meat products .** Please be prepared to do this if you intend to participate. **In addition, as the farm/farmer, you will be responsible for providing one 10'x10' tent during the event.** The restaurant with whom you are paired should provide all cooking equipment, serving dishes and utensils. We will provide one 8' table, compostable plates and utensils, beverage napkins, trashcans, and signage. We also will have a team of volunteers and Farmer Apprentices to help before, during, and after the event.



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\*Please do not bring any disposable materials that you do not plan to take with you.
